Photos – Taking a Screenshot

Screen Shot

Take a screenshot


- 1. Do one of the following:
 - On an iPhone with Face ID: Simultaneously press and then release the side button and volume up button.
 - On an iPhone with a Home button: Simultaneously press and then release the Home button and the side button or Sleep/Wake button (depending on your model).
- 2. Tap the screenshot in the lower-left corner, then tap Done.
- 3. Choose Save to Photos, Save to Files, or Delete Screenshot.

If you choose Save to Photos, you can view it in the Screenshots album in the Photos app, or in the All Photos album if iCloud Photos is turned on in Settings > Photos.

Photos - Searching


- Click the Magnifying Glass Icon

- Pictures will appear matching the search criteria



Photos - Adding a Caption

- Go to Photos
- Open any picture that you like
- Swipe up from that image
- Enter text in caption field
- Click Magnifying Glass Icon to Search






Widgets

Adding a Widget - Home Screen

- Long press on a blank area of the Home Screen
- Once in jiggle mode, tap the plus (+) button in the top-left corner of the screen.
- Scroll through the widgets card or search widgets and then drag it onto the Home Screen.


Safari - Bookmarks


- Bookmarks can be added to the Home Screen of Safari to access most frequently visited sites

 Favorites List and an icon will be added to the Home Screen of Safari








Safari - History


- Click on the History icon to view all previous sites that you visited.

- Then click on the Plus sign






Safari - Opening additional Sites (cont'd)

- To close the website, click the X in the upper right corner







Closing All Applications

Closing All Applications


- Press down with your finger in the lower right corner of the screen
- Swipe UP to close each application













Logging into iCloud.com
